Read the label

Be sure to follow the directions on the product. Every product has different use cases (where you can safely use the product) and cautionary information.

Remember: C before D

Clean before you disinfect! Make sure your surfaces are clean before you disinfect them. Use a multipurpose cleaner or soap and water.

Follow the dwell time

Dwell time or contact time is critical to making sure your disinfectant is killing germs. The surface needs to remain visibly wet for the entire dwell time (listed on the label).

Don't forget your PPE (Personal Protective Equipment)

Follow the label instructions for correct PPE (gloves, coveralls, mask) to wear while you're disinfecting.
